

The "Syndicat mixte <u>Pays du Mans</u>", located at the crossroads between the Greater West and the Paris region, covers 1,611 km² and brings together 92 communes with around 323,000 inhabitants. It is both a hub of activity and a forward-looking territory, committed to ecological transition and fostering complementarity between urban and rural areas.

- Our LAG Pays du Mans has been selected for the 2023–2027 period, with an allocation of €1.3 million. It also has 76,665 inhabitants and covers an area of 942 km², comprising 50 municipalities and 4 groups of municipalities."

Biodiversity loss and climate change are pressing challenges for rural and peri-urban territories across Europe. *Pays du Mans*, with its recognition under the "Territoire Engagé pour la Nature" and "Contrat Nature 2050," has developed policies and actions that combine biodiversity protection, citizen awareness, and sustainable land-use planning through the "Trame Verte et Bleue" (Green and Blue Infrastructure). This experience provides a strong basis for transnational cooperation.

Pays du Mans is also working on the following biodiversity-related themes:

- Water management,
- Light pollution, public lighting (black screen),
- Differentiated management of green spaces...
